Idaho Farms and Ranches: Women and Men Principal Producers by Size of Operation

Idaho has nearly 25,000 farms and 44,000 principal producers. Nearly 40% of Idaho's principal producers are women. There are more than 10,500 women and more than 13,000 men operating 7,881 small farms (1 to 49.9 acres) in Idaho. Idaho has approximately 3,693 large farms (500 – 2000+ acres) that are operated by over 2,100 women and 5,800 men.
