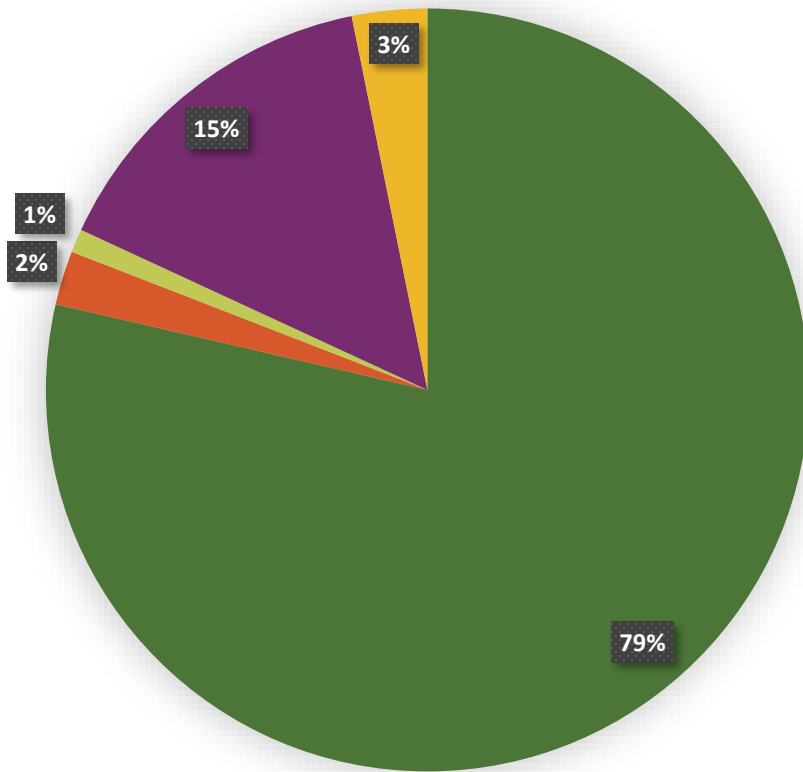


Percent of Idaho Women Primary Producers by Annual Farm Sales

Almost 80 percent of Idaho women primary producers have annual gross farm sales of less than \$150,000, while upwards of 15% of Idaho women primary producers have over \$1,000,000 in annual gross farm sales.



- **Small Scale** – Low Sales (<\$150,000)
 - **Small Scale** – Moderate Sales (\$150,000 – 349,999)
 - **Mid Sized** – (\$350,000 – (\$999,999)
 - **Large Scale** – (\$1,000,000+)
 - **Non-Family** – (any farm where the producer and persons related to the producer do not own a majority of the business)

In analyzing the 2017 Census of Agriculture data, our U of I Research Team designated one farmer per farm as the primary producer. The **primary producer** is the farmer who made the most farm decisions and worked the fewest days off farm.
